I also thank the affiliates who make up AFL Barwon. Our umpires led by Brad Smith in Geelong and by Craig Kerr in Colac, the GFNL and BFNL boards led by Konrad Vinken and Allan Bliss and the GDFNL led by Neville Whitley and the CDFNL under the guidance of Peter Lucas. At our first AGM we reported on the initiatives we were undertaking in 2013.

- Club Health Checks

Each of these initiatives have now been completed and provide a road map for the future direction of football and netball in the region.

Some of the programs/policies we are currently working on include:



- •AFL Vic Player Payments review
- Competition structures
- Club development
- •Highton office upgrade
- Appointment of a Regional Director of Umpiring
- •G21 Regional Strategy

The first 5 of these programs are a work in progress but the G21 Regional Strategy is now completed.

The G21 strategy sourced information from clubs, leagues, peak bodies and other stakeholders- and works to identify areas of strength and weakness- of opportunity and threat. The focus is to plan for optimal club development and sustainability – both in terms of facilities and club viability. This includes:

- •Financial sustainability and strategic management support
- ·Lighting of grounds
- •Redevelopment facilities to cater for all participants
- •Improve retention rates for participants (players & umpires)
- •Improve structures to create links between football & netball programs- Auskick, schools, Juniors
- •Planning that provides for new facility development required to support growth

The strategy defines minimum standards for club facilities and upgrades to provide regional grounds to cater for all levels of sporting contests. It is expected that all 13 Regional Football Commissions will complete a similar strategy over the next few years. AFL Barwon is very grateful for the input from both AFL Vic and the G21 members for their support and contribution to this ground breaking initiative that will prove to be invaluable to all stakeholders.

Across the state there are now 13 Football Commissions in place - all working toward the common goals as identified in the Jackson review into Country Football.

I encourage all of our stakeholders to take the time to look at the programs and plans that AFL Barwon have developed.

The Commission is committed to enabling the growth and prosperity of football, netball and umpiring in the Barwon region and to the viability of all clubs in the region.

The transition from Football & Netball Geelong to AFL Barwon has not impacted significantly on the operations unit in our organisation. The provision of effective leadership and governance across our many competitions in Football and Netball also missed the finals in what was one of the most even incorporating both Senior and Junior participants in the Geelong, Bellarine, Surfcoast and Colac districts continues to be our primary focus.

This year we welcomed Sean Atkinson to the Operation's Team. Having replaced Luke Maher as Football Co-ordinator, Sean quickly adapted to the role and has successfully managed the Junior football programs, as well as effectively overseeing data management and serving as a useful resource and support for club volunteers.

The Under 18 ½ Colts structure continued to develop this year, with 36 teams representing a total of 26 clubs registered for the 2014 season, including a team from Winchelsea for the first time in many years..

We again conducted 4 divisions with 10.10.8 & 8 teams competing respectively in each division. In most instances the games were evenly contested, therefore allowing the clubs placed Unfortunately Forrest were again unable to provide junior teams in the lower divisions the opportunity to experience potential success, whilst those in the higher divisions were challenged each week, thus enhancing their development for future years. Players from 15 different clubs experienced finals football. We were fortunate enough to host our 2 local interleague campaigns at Simonds Stadium with mixed results again occurring. The GFL Senior representative team was again victorious with an emphatic victory over Peninsula FNL to retain the bragging rights as the number one Team in Country Victoria, but the Bellarine Senior team was disappointing after a 2nd half fade out saw them soundly beaten by Casey Cardinia FNL. Bell Park Coach Tim Sheringham led from the front, winning the Bob Cahir Trophy for the GFL's best on ground. Drysdale defender Stephen Bensted won the Bull Bennett Medal for best BFL player.

Both Under 18 teams had terrific contests with the GFL winning by 2 points, and the BFL losing by one point. These results were mirrored in the netball with the GFNL having a win, but the BFNL netballers suffering a loss.

I would like to thank all football coaches; Glen Wallace, Matt Verfurth, James Garvey, Neville Daffy, David McCormick and their Management of data associated with AFL Barwon competitions coaching staff for the time and effort that they provided during the continues to be a huge task with expectations from the governing preparation and on match day. I would also like to thank the support staff who volunteered their time and effort to ensure the players and leagues had all they needed to get the teams onto the field. Gary Holt and Brian (Bull) Bennett from the BFNL, and Charlie Johnson and his helpers from the GFNL all did a great job, as did their support staff and trainers. I would also like to echo the appreciation expressed by Nikki in her Netball Report to all the coaches and support volunteers who provided their time. expertise and effort to ensure the Netball Interleague experience was positive and successful.

BFNL

Once again the top 6 teams were very even throughout the season with Geelong Amateur proving the dominant team throughout the home and away season. Whilst Torquay were once again a strong contender, Ocean Grove were the big improvers and Barwon Heads finally broke through for a finals appearance. An under manned Ocean Grove team proved no match in the Grand Final to a very powerful, star studded Geelong Amateur line up.

After coming 3rd in 2013, young Torquay mid fielder James Darke won the Les Ash medal, 3 votes clear of Nicholas Hill from Barwon Heads.

GFNL

2014 heralded a changing of the guard with the league powerhouse of the past decade South Barwon failing to make the finals for the first time in that period. Their era of success included

playing in 9 out of the last 13 grand finals of which they won 8. With a strong junior base and positive club culture, they are sure to bounce back in 2015. Their grand final opponents from 2013 competitions witnessed in recent GFL history. Leopold, Colac, St Joseph, Newtown & Chilwell and St Mary's were hard to split throughout the season, with Leopold emerging as minor premiers going into the finals series. Colac's victory in the elimination final sparked the start of a fairytale series, which saw them overcome a young Leopold side in the Grand Final to win their first GFL

The Mathieson medal was another thrilling count, with Guy O'Keefe from Leopold polling 3 votes in the last game to overtake Newtown & Chilwell's Matthew McMahon who again took out the runner's up trophy.

The Colac & District FNL continue to conduct a very strong and vibrant competition.

BARWON JUNIOR CHAMPS

The Barwon Junior Champs begun in 2014, as a competition for elite netballers in the Geelong and surrounding regions to have an elite Netball Victoria competition closer to home. In the first year of the competition GFNL and BFNL representative teams in the 13 & Under, 15 & Under and 17 & under age groups competed. The competition was held every Monday night at Geelong Basketball Netball Centre.

Because of the comp only having 4 teams in the first year all of our teams were lucky enough to participate in finals. Our BFNL 15's and GFNL 13's were unlucky to miss out on Grand finals going down by the smallest of margins.

The 13 & Under Grand Finals was played by the BFNL 13's and GCNA 13's. The Bellarine team lead most of the game but were unable to hold on with GCNA taking the lead in the dying minute to win by two goals. The 15's Grand Final was played by GFNL 15's and Kardinia Lynx 15's. GFNL got off to a strong start extending their lead out to 10 goals in the second guarter. Kardinia didn't lie down fighting to the last minute and fought their way back into the game. GFNL held onto the charge from Kardinia winning the Grand Final by 3 goals. In the 17 & Under Grand Final we had a battle between our two league with GFNL taking on BFNL. - We also initiated an AFL 9's Adult Social Competition based at Deakin YMCA.

Community

We were able to support leagues and clubs to provide quality management and environments to motivate volunteers, umpires and coaches at all levels through the Barwon region:

- We worked with all of the GFL, BFL, GDFL, CDFL, GFUL and CFUL Football and Netball Clubs to deliver outcomes for the AFL Barwon Commission including an extensive Club Health Check review and Facilities Audit process that will underpins the G21 and AFL Barwon Strategic Plan.
- We continued to support and communicate with AFL Barwon clubs to generate club objectives and outcomes.
- We accredited approx. 180 coaches through our Senior, Youth and x 2 Junior/Auskick coaching courses.
- We coordinated Coaching Forums in conjunction with the Geelong FC.




