AFL Barwon Report

Under the guidance of newly appointed Chairman, Peter Hickey and a refreshed governance structure, the 2019 Colac & District FNL season has been very successful for both football and netball in the region, highlighted by the terrific spectator support across the finals series.

As the administrative body of the CDFNL, AFL Barwon is committed to continuous improvement of our service delivery by providing sound governance and oversight of the CDFNL member clubs and the competition of which they compete. There has been significant change in 2019 to AFL Victoria's head office structures to enable a more streamlined management system which is driving some outstanding outcomes to our participants across the whole of Victoria. The AFL, in partnership with the Victorian State Government announced an additional \$18 million investment into Victorian country football from 2020-2022. The three-year funding announcement marks the largest investment in country football in Victoria in more than two decades.

The funding will support country football communities through targeted initiatives, providing immediate financial relief to clubs and volunteers and ensure the long-term sustainability of the game through the growth of grassroots participation. The initiatives include the removal of AFL Victoria affiliation fees, which will save country football clubs a total of \$3.22 million each year, the removal of umpire registration fees and significant reduction in the cost of club apparel. This will see clubs in the AFL Barwon region retain over \$400,000 and should delight the many hard-working volunteers that continue to keep club doors open for future generations.

The region is now in its fourth year of operation under the Club Sustainability system which ensures clubs now look more closely than ever at their junior programs and invest in player recruitment strategies. With Salary Caps now fully cemented in the local football landscape, clubs should find relief knowing that they do not have find ways of covering excessive spending to compete each week. Both systems will continue to be reviewed and improved on an annual basis, in conjunction with AFL Victoria.

As Region General Manager for just over 12 months, it has been a pleasure working with the CDFNL Board led by Peter Hickey. With a revised governance structure that has seen football and netball working more closely than ever, the board should be thanked for their leadership and guidance across all clubs. It is felt that the CDFNL Board and AFL Barwon have a terrific working relationship and we look forward to this continuing into the future.

All volunteer roles can be thankless at times, but it certainly does not go unnoticed and you should be proud of your efforts. All CDFNL clubs continue to provide safe and welcoming environments for families that allows relief from the working week. Without the many volunteers, that relief would not be possible. AFL Barwon this year introduced “The Game Plan” event to assist in a streamlined education approach for all volunteers and we hope that the CDFNL volunteers attend with keen interest in 2020.

On behalf of AFL Barwon we look forward to continuing our relationship into 2020 and supporting the Board and all clubs.

As Football Development Managers, in 2019 we have delivered numerous development Programs for AFL Victoria, as well as producing critical outcomes for the AFL Barwon Region through targeted League/Club Development Programs and strategies throughout 2019

The FDM role requires a lot of work behind the scenes to ensure that our sport remains relevant and that the next generation join and remain at clubs in our region. Some of the responsibilities include:

Ensuring effective participation pathway and transition between age groups.

Supporting clubs with management, training, emergency support

Managing the implementation of the state strategy of NAB AFL Auskick and School Football Programs.

Managing other development programs related to umpiring, coaching, volunteer support, fans, while increasing diversity through female football, multicultural and indigenous and AAA programs.

To capitalise on growth opportunities.

Assist with infrastructure planning.

Deliver AFL Victoria development and promotional programs throughout our region.

As you can see from the brief overview, the position description is quite varied and involves work across all areas of our game.

Highlights

AUSKICK

We provided support to 252 NAB Auskick participants across the 4 centres in the Colac Region.

Auskick Super Clinic was once again a huge success with over 1500 kids filling GMHBA stadium to meet the Geelong players and show off their Auskick skills.

The Auskick Challenge was established in August to assist with the transition of Auskickers into Junior Football. 28 teams participated at the North Geelong Football Netball Club.

JUNIOR FOOTBALL

The Colac Junior Reference Committee rolled out the findings for change the age groups for junior football across the CDFNL.

A new competition was introduced changing the age groups to Under 13, Under 15 and Under 18. There was also a stand alone (school based) Under 11 competition on a Friday night.

In 2018, 632 players under the age of 18 played in CDFNL competitions (including last years Under 12 competition).

This year 692 players played in CDFNL competitions (including this years Under 11 competition).

SCHOOL

We supported all of our 130 AFL School Ambassadors and School Competitions including primary and secondary SSV and GISSA competitions.

We continued to promote the game of AFL to school participants through the Sporting Schools Program and School Clinics across 39 schools. Dylan Slater did an amazing job at reaching Primary Schools across the Colac Region.

259 Coaches have participated in Coaching Workshops throughout 2019.

We worked with GFNL, BFNL, GDFL, CDFNL, GFUL and CFUL Football and Netball Clubs to implement outcomes that are outlined in the recently released G21 and AFL Barwon Strategic Plan. The Bell Park Dragons FIDA team continued to go from strength to strength . A huge thank you to Bell Park FNC, Leisure Networks, Tegan Curwood and Tim Downes for their foresight and hard work. We facilitated and organised community education presentations for AFL Barwon aligned Clubs, which included topics consisting of: Vilification and Discrimination, Cyberbullying, Respect and Responsibility, Gambling and Drug & Alcohol Awareness.

FANS

We worked hard to develop our 'fans of the game' by working closely with the Geelong FC, some initiatives included:

Working with Geelong to coordinate all of the AFL Player Appearances at schools, junior clubs, NAB Auskick centres and community events with Country Day.

Assistance in bringing the Geelong Cats Community team to the Colac Region for Healthy Heroes and School Clinic visits in August.

We collaborated on the NAB Auskick Super Clinic for approx. 1,500 participants at Simonds as well as the Geelong FC Junior member's clinic for approximately 800 kids.

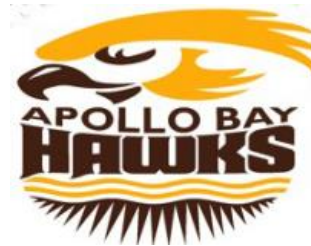
