# CHAIRMAN REPORT



Welcome to the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Report of the AFL Barwon Football Commission Ltd. This AGM is the formal record of the activities and the financial status of the AFL Barwon Commission.

As is the case every year we acknowledge the great work of the army of volunteers who make our games of football and netball so special. The Football and Netball games we present are of the highest standard in regional Australia and the benefits that flow to our community as a result should never be underestimated. Our communities are better places to live in as a result of the activities our clubs promote. You just cannot imagine living in a community that does not have a Football Netball club. It is incumbent on all of us to strive to create an environment that allows all of our clubs to provide opportunities for participation and pathways for excellence.

The proposed Competition restructure has been removed from the agenda for 2019 in response to representations made by our member clubs and leagues. The Commission has resolved to revisit the policy and to engage with our affiliates to better understand the concerns that clubs have with regard to

this policy. To that end AFL Barwon will review the work done to this stage and work with all stakeholders to achieve the outcomes of club sustainability and competitiveness that we all aspire to. The Commission will look at all options to achieve the best outcome for Football and Netball.

AFL Barwon is introducing a Player Payments and Points system for Netball in 2019. There is widespread support for the formulation of this policy and the detail has been presented to Netball leaders for feedback and comment. This initiative has the support of Netball Victoria and has the potential to provide even greater competitiveness and interest in our A Grade Netball competitions. Our Netball operations team have done a great job in producing this policy.

AFL Barwon has just completed the review into Junior Football in Colac and district. This important piece of work is currently being discussed with the clubs and leagues. The focus on this policy is to develop and enhance participation and to ensure viable pathways for young people to play Junior Football in and around Colac.

Female football is booming in the region. The Grand Final day at Grovedale clearly illustrated the growth and interest in the Women's Football. This can only get bigger and better as the competition evolves. With careful planning and promotion the game will only get better in the years ahead.

Junior football in the region continues to grow. The evenness of the Junior competitions is providing a fertile environment in which to grow participation. The Grand Final weekend at Lara was a demonstration of all that is great in our game. Huge crowds entertained by the spirited competition at all levels along with a wonderful community atmosphere made it a weekend to savour.

Umpiring continues to be a focus of AFL Barwon. The AFL Barwon Umpire Academy has been expanded into several new schools in 2018. This initiative is a key to the recruitment of more young people into our umpiring ranks. The development of a library of umpire training skills and other on line tools is another feature that will be of benefit to umpires and clubs into the future.

Integrity is a major focus of the Commission and our Football and Netball Operations team. The Match Review Panel and Tribunal members are charged with the responsibility of ensuring a fair and proper process is in place to enforce our integrity measures. Off field integrity and governance measures are constantly being evaluated and reviewed as the expectations and standards of our community increase. The challenges that arise from new communication media and technology require constant scrutiny. The integrity of all of our rules and policies will continue to be administered with fairness and rigour.

2018 sees the departure of our inaugural Region General Manager Lee Hartman. Lee moves on after 11 years of service to the region and his contribution has been immense. We wish him well in his future endeavours. Will McGregor has been appointed as RGM and brings a great skill set to the role. During this year Greg Welsh and Andrew Downie, both of whom have served as Deputy Chair, have announced their retirement from the Commission. Both men are great servants to the region and deserve our thanks.

In closing I would like to thank all of the AFL Barwon affiliates for their dedication to the Community and to our sports. Your dedication and passion is what drives our clubs to ever greater heights.

Combining Football and Netball, AFL Barwon now has over 18,000 participants, highlighted by a 37% increase in Female Football teams and a 14% increase in senior Netball teams. With over 500 registered umpires and 3,100 Auskickers, the region is generally in a very healthy state.

This growth would not happen without the many tireless hours that are put in at club level. The volunteers across the region are as passionate and proud as any and the work that they do to ensure all clubs are viable across the region should always be recognised. Congratulations to the Club Executives, Members, Players and many Volunteers. The Drain Man and Cleanaway, Medibank and G-Force are now very much a part of our organisation and our continued growth could not be possible without your support. To all partners who make significant contributions, AFL Barwon cannot thank you enough and we hope to strengthen these relationships into the future as we strive to create safe and inclusive environments at all clubs.

In 2019, AFL Barwon will be updating the G21 Strategy document in order to have a coordinated approach to facility and infrastructure upgrades. AFL Barwon continues to receive excellent support and cooperation from our shires and councils and we are excited to work with you going forward to produce the most up to date strategy document across the state that will benefit all member clubs.

The region is fortunate to have all AFL Barwon staff continuing to challenge new ideas and concepts and work thanklessly in order to produce the best possible football and netball matches across Victoria, if not, Australia at a community level. There is no doubt that the Operations team is one of the most experienced across the state. I have thoroughly enjoyed working with Michael Limb, Sean Atkinson, Sarah Scott, Tayla Ellis, Jock Hillgrove, Deb Thewlis, Matt Lindsay, Ray Berry and Josh Conway across 2018. The Club Sustainability Program is now firmly entrenched in our region, ensuring the long-term viability of all clubs and without the AFL Barwon staff driving this, Salary Cap and Player Points System governance would not be as sound as it currently is. In 2019, AFL Barwon will look to introduce these systems into Netball and Female Football to ensure clubs are investing in their junior programs.

The Football Development team in Luke Maher, Jess Smith, Katie Geerings and Sarah Scott have continued to deliver high quality programs for the region in areas such as Auskick, Schools, Coach Education, Inclusion and Diversity, AFL Player appearances at clubs and schools, Training and Education, Next Generation Academies and V/Line Cup programs as well as the work they are doing with many club's committees and volunteers. The development team continue to be progressive and look to innovate and I congratulate them on their work and encourage all clubs to form relationships with the Football Development Managers as they can support you across a range of areas.

On a personal note, I would like to thank and congratulate outgoing Region General Manager Lee Hartman. Lee has driven progressive change in many areas and the strength of the Regional Administration Centre and all competitions are what they are because of the many tireless hours Lee has put in. All staff at AFL Barwon wish Lee all the very best in his future endeavours.

Congratulations to St. Joseph's FNC and Newtown & Chilwell FNC in the GFNL and Modewarre FNC in the BFNL for your very successful Premiership year. All clubs are striving for similar on field and on court success and there is no doubt, many hours have and are being spent to prepare to go one better in 2019.

The AFL Barwon Commission led by Chairman Craig Keating have shown terrific support to all AFL Barwon staff and will continue to make decisions that have the best interest of the entire region at the forefront of their minds. There are many challenges we continue to face but there is no doubt the future is exciting for Football and Netball as we now turn our minds to 2019.

## OPERATIONS MANAGER REPORT



Our Region continues to lead the way with the implementation of AFL Victoria's Community Club Sustainability Program. The Player Payments and Player Points programs have now been fully implemented across the state, with the long term outcomes aimed at assisting clubs to ensure their viability well into the future. We have now developed clearly defined Policies and procedures for these programs that will assist all stakeholders with a sense of clarity and understanding of what is required.

#### Under 19s

Outcomes implemented from the Junior Review, saw all junior age groups change in 2018. This resulted in a drop in eligible players at the top end, with no bottom age players coming up. Therefore the number of teams was reduced from 36 teams to 27 teams with only 3 clubs entering a 2<sup>nd</sup> team.

We conducted 3 divisions with,8,12 & 7 teams competing respectively in each division. This was again an evenly contested year in most grades including hotly contested finals series in all grades with players from 12 different clubs experiencing finals football. With bottom age players progressing from the Under 17s, it is envisaged there will be more teams entered in the Under 19 competition in 2019.

#### Interleague

After nearly a decade as the Number 1 Country League in Victoria and the reigning Number 1 League across the state in both Metropolitan & Country Football, the GFNL suffered their first loss in representative football since 2010 at the hands of a strong finishing Eastern Football League who kicked 8 goals in the last quarter. The game was played at Etihad Stadium as a curtain raiser to the AFL's Country Round Clash between St Kilda

and Collingwood. The Bob Cahir Memorial Medal for best player on the ground was awarded to St Mary's young gun Jack Blood. Unfortunately, due to the fixturing of the game at the Etihad, there was no under 19 football or Netball played.

After missing out on a game in 2017, the BFNL returned to interleague football with a strong win in Horsham against the Wimmera FNL. This was a great result having suffered a narrow defeat to the Wimmera at the same venue 3 years ago. Fast ball movement and explosive speed was the key for the BFNL's success, but the winner of the Brian "Bull" Bennett medal for best on the ground went to Ocean Grove ruckman Andrew Jarvis, who controlled the air and provided the opportunity for our running players to create plenty of scoring opportunities for our key forwards with Anglesea's Jordan Erskine kicking 6 goals.

I would like to thank our new GFNL football coach; Clinton Wells, BFNL Coach Mark Hildebrandt and their coaching staff for the time and effort that they provided during the preparation and on match day. I would also like to thank the support staff who volunteered their time and effort to ensure the players and leagues had all they needed to get the teams onto the field.

#### BFNL

In what was the closest season in recent years, Barwon Heads led the way, only dropping 2 games throughout the home and away season. After the 18 rounds, only 3 wins separated the next 6 teams, with Ocean Grove & last year's premiers Torquay narrowly missing the finals action. Only percentage separated Modewarre, Geelong Amateur & Queenscliff, with Anglesea one win ahead of them. The first weekend saw strong wins to Geelong Amateur and Modewarre. Barwon Heads easily accounted for Modewarre in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semi final to storm into their first Grand Final since they won it in 1993 (15 years ago), whilst Anglesea ended Geelong Amateur's hopes to play Modewarre in the Preliminary Final. Modewarre found some form with a strong victory over Anglesea, earning another crack at Barwon Heads in the Grand Final. With Barwon Heads wasteful in front of goal, (5.16) and a hard fought well drilled performance Modewarre won their first senior flag since joining the BFNL in 1996 (22 years ago)

Barwon Heads recruit Mitchell Phelps won the BFL League goal kicking with 77 goals, whilst Anglesea utility Jackson Bews and Barwon Heads mid fielder Matt Dyer tied to win the Les Ash Medal.

#### **GFNL**

Leopold dominated the home and away season finishing on top with 17 wins. St Mary's & St Joseph's also had very strong seasons with only 3 and 4 losses respectively. They were closely followed by South Barwon & Colac. Newtown & Chilwell and Bell Park narrowly missed finals. The much-improved South Barwon ended Colac's finals campaign, St Mary's inflicted a 9 goal defeat on reigning Premiers St Joseph's in their Qualifying Final clash, and followed it up with a strong win against ladder leaders Leopold to book a spot in their 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive Grand Final. St Joseph's then rebounded against a young South Barwon to book a must win Preliminary Final against Leopold. In wintery conditions at GMHBA Stadium, St Joseph's looked to have the game in their control at three quarter time, 15 points up (17 scoring shots to 7) in a low scoring affair, but kicking with the aid of a strong wind, Leopold almost stole the match going down by a solitary point. The 2017 Grand Final rematch saw an epic game which saw St Mary's hold the early ascendancy, but St Joseph's took control of the match in the final quarter and held on to record an exciting 9 point victory over a disappointed St Mary's side.

The Mathieson medal was an emphatic victory for 2017 winner Newtown & Chilwell's Matthew McMahon who finished 12 votes ahead of 2016 winner and last year's joint runner up Nathan Deans from Grovedale. Gun St Mary's recruit Aiden Grace won the Goal kicking with 55 Goals.

#### <u>CDFNL</u>

The Colac & District FNL had another very successful year, with many quality players finding their way to CDFNL teams.

Last year's Premiers Birregurra were again the pace setters, finishing the Home & Away season with 16 wins, only one loss and a draw, with their closest rivals Lorne & South Colac close behind them with 3 and 4 losses respectively. Alvie and Simpson again filled the remaining positions in the final five. Lorne and Alvie won their way through the first weekend of the finals. The 2<sup>nd</sup> week saw Birregurra stamp their authority with a strong win over a wasteful Lorne and South Colac account for Alvie. Lorne responded strongly with a good win over South Colac to set up another exciting Grand Final with Lorne. Lorne jumped out of the blocks early with the aid of the wind, to be 4 goals up at quarter time. Birregurra were not able to get their game going, and despite a gallant effort were unable to bridge the gap, with Lorne recording a strong 21 point victory.

The Mahoney Medal was again an amazing count with Alvie's Mark Riley leading Lorne's Mark McCormack by only 1 vote entering round 18. With Alvie playing Lorne in the final round and both players competing in the ruck, it was an exciting final game, which saw Mark McCormack get the 3 votes to claim back to back Mahoney Medals. Otway Districts' coach Tom Mullane-Grant won the goal kicking trophy with 76 goals in the home and away games.

Interleague was played at Central Reserve with a clash against the Kyabram & District Football League, again led by coach Steve O'Dowd. Our senior interleague campaign this year was much more successful with a strong home win. We thank Steve for the time and effort that he put in. We could not have asked any more of him and result was well deserved.

I would again like to thank Lee Hartman for his ongoing support and professional leadership. Having decided to move on in his career after 11 years with our organisation, I would like it noted that his period of tenure has produced incredible growth, increased professionalism, and much improved resources for our clubs. He has certainly left us better for his contribution. I would also like to thank and acknowledge the rest of our staff, our Operations team of Sean, Tayla, Matt and Jock, as well as Deb who keeps it all together for us. The contribution made by the FDMs is an extremely important component in the service we are able to provide for the clubs, and their work has been outstanding this year. I would again like to express again my appreciation to all the club volunteers for their hours of work committed to ensuring all the required tasks are performed in a timely and efficient manner. They are often thankless tasks but are vital and very much appreciated by all here at AFL Barwon.

# JUNIOR NETBALL REPORT



#### **AFL Barwon Junior Netball**

In total for our AFL Barwon Junior Netball competitions this year we had 61 teams participate on a Tuesday night in the 11 & Under comp (46 at Kardinia Park and 15 at Ocean Grove) and on Friday night we had 68 teams participate from 13 & Under (33 teams), 15 & under (26 teams), 17 & Under (9 teams).

I would like to give a massive thanks to Matt Lindsay for organising the junior competitions and running them on a Friday and Tuesday night. Thank you also to Kelley Weldon who assisted Matt on Friday nights and Tuesdays at Ocean Grove. It would be impossible to run the competitions without her.

Thank you to our Friday night umpire supervisors Shirley Fagan and Ange Cripps, and to the many Friday night mentors throughout the year. We have had a large number of new umpires begin in our Friday night competition this year and many have started to move up to be trainees, and then on to working to become badged umpires.

#### **Umpiring**

Our Friday night umpire mentoring program saw our mentors provide training, feedback and encouragement for our junior umpires throughout the season. Working with 70 junior umpires, we were able to develop their skills and confidence to work their way back to their clubs to umpire. Many of our umpires are now permanent fixtures each week at their clubs as club umpires, and majority of our umpires were able to progress through to the next level throughout the season.

Although we are still working on improving our Panel umpire program, we managed to take some steps to improve the quality of umpiring throughout by implementing a mentor program for 13/U all the way up to A grade. Thank you to all clubs who supported AFL Barwon with Panel umpiring this year, with last minute changes and calling upon club umpires to help fill spots. This year we worked very hard in developing and gaining new younger members onto our panel. This program will continue in 2018 where we are in the process of adding more umpires to our Panel list.

I wouldn't have been able to get umpires across 22 A & B grade games each week throughout the year without the help and support of the umpire development panel, Heather Carroll, Cheryl Van Dreumel, Kate Harding and Shirley Fagan. With the support of these ladies not only have we allocated panel every week, but have work with umpires to get there umpiring badges.

# UMPIRING REPORT



It gives me great pleasure to present my annual report for 2018.

Although for the first time ever AFL Barwon reached **501 umpire participants**, this didn't necessarily translate to "actual" weekend Colac/Geelong Association umpire numbers. Geelong was impacted with the introduction of Sunday boy's and Senior Women's competitions, with Geelong reaching **345** (-20) umpires, coaches and support staff, while Colac grew from 71 umpires to **74** (+3) including coaches. Another **82** (+32) people registered as participating in umpiring as registered club appointed umpires and School based umpire academies.

Umpiring needs more people involved as the rapid growth of the game is still well ahead of any growth of umpires numbers. **Geelong Umpires have a bold target of 700 umpires while**Colac Umpires need 100+

AFL Barwon introduced an all abilities Umpire Program mid 2018 through the supporting efforts of AFL Barwon Commissioner Richard Underwood and Geelong Umpire Brendan Beveridge where participants were identified and able to be trained and umpire in a live match late in the season.

The AFL Barwon Region umpiring was again very well represented with umpires and umpire coaches from Geelong and Colac in the AFL Victoria 2018 Worksafe Country Championships, V/Line Umpire Academy, V/Line Cup and TAC Cup matches. Congratulations to all umpires who participated.

Our AFL Barwon School Based Umpire Academies again proved valuable with students participating in an umpiring specific programs at Clonard, St Joseph's Colleges (Geelong) and Trinity College (Colac).

AFL barwon engaged Chelsea Roffey (AFL Umpire) as AFL Barwon Umpire Ambassador. Chelsea delivered a number of promotional and recruiting videos (\*40,000 unique views – Facebook) along with 4 PD sessions (1 Colac and 3 Geelong), Clonard College Umpire Academy session and attended several other events as part of her role.

AFL Barwon High Performance Umpire Academy again partnered with the Geelong Falcons, David Harris (AFL Umpire) lead the group. Thank you also to Mick Turner (Falcons GM) for his support of the program which is the only TAC club to have an affiliated umpire program, unique to AFL Barwon.

The last possession rule was introduced by AFL Barwon in 2018, the rule allowed for clubs to no longer needing to find a boundary umpire and most importantly there was **no players throwing the ball in** a key delivery of the AFL Barwon Commission. Where the rule was implemented we removed boundary throw-ins and replaced this with a field ball up 15m on to the ground.

In closing I would like to thank the AFL Barwon Commission, AFL Barwon Staff and Geelong Umpires BoM, CDFUA, GDFL executive, and all AFL Barwon/GDFL clubs. I would particularly like to thank Lee Hartman for his leadership and support of umpiring and wish him well in his future endeavors.

# TRIBUNAL REPORT

The process for Reporting, Set Penalties & MRP that was adopted in 2017, continued to provide consistencies in outcomes and also a reduction in unnecessary Tribunal hearings.

There were a total of 107 reports laid across AFL Barwon leagues in the 2018 season. This was a slight drop from last year.

These reports comprised 64 Senior Grade, 10 Reserve Grade, 13 Under 19s, 17 from Junior Grades, 1 Netball, 2 from Female Football, and included 1 charge carried over from 2016. This includes 6 reports heard at Tribunal as a result of investigations at the request of Clubs, Umpires or League for various incidents, and 13 that were referred by the Match Review Panel.

60 players accepted the set penalty option. A total of 187 matches will be or have been missed by players through suspensions received in 2018. A significant reduction from last year.

Our Match Review Panel assessed 103 requests of which they found 39 reportable offences. 23 of these players accepted set penalties, 1 accepted a reprimand, 2 clubs were fined for engaging in a Melee, 6 were sent straight to tribunal and 7 challenged their charge at Tribunal with 11 found guilty. Our appreciation is extended to the members of the MRP who volunteered their time on a weekly basis to assess relevant footage as requested and provide their judgements. Tribunal results would indicate that their judgements were appropriate.

I would like to congratulate Chairman Werner Weigl and his panel members for their work and measured but consistent approach. Arthur Hodgson and Damian McKeegan also did a great job as our League Prosecutors.

I would like to thank Rob Drew for his work as Tribunal Secretary with the co-ordination, scheduling and running of the Tribunal sessions, I would also like to thank our Director of Umpiring Jock Hillgrove for his work co-ordinating and organizing the umpires and their advocates.

## FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT REPORT

As Football Development Managers, in 2018 we have delivered numerous development Programs for AFL Victoria, as well as producing critical outcomes for the AFL Barwon Region through targeted League/Club Development Programs and strategies throughout 2018

The FDM role requires a lot of work behind the scenes to ensure that our sport remains relevant and that the next generation join and remain at clubs in our region. Some of the responsibilities include:

- Ensuring effective participation pathway and transition between age groups.
- Supporting clubs with management, training, emergency support
- Managing the implementation of the state strategy of NAB AFL Auskick and School Football Programs.
- Managing other development programs related to umpiring, coaching, volunteer support, fans, while increasing diversity through female football, multicultural and indigenous and AAA programs.
- To capitalise on growth opportunities.
- Assist with infrastructure planning.
- Deliver AFL Victoria development and promotional programs throughout our region.

As you can see from the brief overview, the position description is quite varied and involves work across all areas of our game.

#### **AUSKICK**

- We provided support to 3100 NAB Auskick participants across 42 centres. We also experienced a 22% increase in female Auskickers with the largest growth segment being 5 -9yrs for girls and 5 -7yrs for boys
- Auskcik Superclinic was once again a huge success with over 1500 kids filling GMHBA stadium to meet the Geelong players and show off their Auskick skill

#### **SCHOOL**

- We supported all of our 130 AFL School Ambassadors and School Competitions including primary and secondary SSV and GISSA competitions.
- We continued to promote the game of AFL to school participants through the Sporting Schools Program across 21 schools.

#### **COACHING**

- 382 Coaches have participated in Coaching Workshops throughout 2018.
- Establishment of the Pathway Coaching Academy with 34 coaches inducted.
- 202 people attended the Dinner

- The Next Generation Academies were established and consisted of a boys U13, U14 & U15 squad, girls U13 & U15 Squad and a development squad
- We conducted the Geelong regional Kickstart and All Nationas trials for Aboriginal and Multicultural players U15. Which resulted in over 8 players being selected for the Victorian squad.
- We were involved with the organization and running of the Worksafe Community Championships, Herald Sun Shield School football competitions and other representative games at club and school levels.
- We managed and coordinated the V/Line Cup program for 49 Under 15 boys and 25 Under 16 girls.
- In its fourth year, the Colac Academy consisted of 36 boys from the Colac region who participated in the 4 session program.

#### PROMOTIONAL

- School Holiday Program with 90 participants across two programs
- Footy Frenzy held at AWA Alliance Bank Stadium with 300 participants
- Geelong hosted its first Free Footy Festival with 700+ kids receiving a free footy and many more families braving the wet weather to enjoy the celebration of football on Grand Final Eve
- FDM's attend many festivals and events to help promote football in our regions, some of which include Pako Festa, Geelong Show, and Gala days

#### **CLUB & REGION DEVELOPMENT**

- We worked with GFNL, BFNL, GDFL, CDFNL, GFUL and CFUL Football and Netball Clubs to implement outcomes that are outlined in the recently released G21 and AFL Barwon Strategic Plan.
- We established a Senior Women's competition, and grew the total number of women's teams in the region from 3 to 13 women's teams.
- The Bell Park Dragons FIDA team continued to go from strength to strength. A huge thank you to Bell Park FNC, Leisure Networks and Tim Downes for their foresight and hard work.
- We facilitated and organised community education presentations for AFL Barwon aligned Clubs, which included topics consisting of: Vilification and Discrimination, Cyberbullying,
   Respect and Responsibility, Gambling and Drug & Alcohol Awareness.
- 382 Coaches attended AFL Barwon coach's association workshops throughout 2018

#### **FANS**

We worked hard to develop our 'fans of the game' by working closely with the Geelong FC, some inititives included:

- Working with Geelong to coordinate all of the AFL Player Appearances at schools, junior clubs, NAB Auskick centres and community events.
- We collaborated on the NAB Auskick Superclinic for approx. 1,500 participants at Simonds as well as the Geelong FC Junior member's clinic for approximately 800 kids.
- Geelong Cats Community Camp was held in Colac, which tied into the Country Game for Geelong v Essendon. The camp consisted of School, Auskick, club and community engagement for the region.





Anglesea Football and Netball Clubs had reasonably successful seasons in 2018. The netball girls battled a player number problem throughout the season but, with good junior numbers the future appears very positive.

The football club made terrific progress on the field. The Under 17s were defeated in their grand final by less than a goal and all other junior teams had excellent numbers under some wise coaching. The Seniors were defeated at preliminary final stage by eventual premiers, Modewarre, but generally played at a very high standard. It was pleasing to see an influx of players keen to represent Anglesea along with the core of locals.

Parental involvement was excellent in every aspect of junior netball and football.






